DAY02: DUSSELDORF/COLOGNE/FRANKFURT

(Dinner)

- Cologne – Cologne Cathedral, Roman Catholic Cathedral, Gothic Masterpiece. • UNESCO World Heritage Site.



DAY03: FRANKFURT/NUREMBURG

(Buffet Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

- Frankfurt City tour – Romer Town Hall, St. Paul's Church, Frankfurt cathedral, Berliner Strasse • Nuremburg – Bavaria's second largest city. Historical Old Town, famous for the Nuremburg sausages with sauerkraut

DAY04: NUREMBURG/KARLOVY VARY/PRAGUE

(Buffet Breakfast, Dinner)

- Karlovy Vary – Most beautiful spa town in the Bohemian Region. Colonnades with natural mineral water from the springs



DAY05: PRAGUE

(Buffet Breakfast, Lunch, Traditional Czech Dinner)

- Prague – Capital of the Czech Republic Walking tour to Charles bridge, Astronomical clock, Prague Castle, Hradcany Castle, St. Vitus Cathedral • Free time to explore the city or mingle with the locals at Wenceslas Square



DAY06: PRAGUE /CESKY KRUMLOV/BOHEMIA REGION

- Cesky Krumlov – the most picturesque town in Europe, UNESCO World Heritage Site, with a stunning castle above the Vitava River

DAY07 BOHEMIA REGION /BRNO

- Today, we travel from Cesky Krumlov to Brno, an administrative center of the Czech Republic • Orientation tour of Brno old town

DAY08: BRNO/AUSCHWITZ CONCENTRATION CAMP/KRAKOW

- Historic Nazi Auschwitz Concentration Camp (Entry subject to opening day/times) • Continue with Krakow old town tour and visit the Medieval Cloth Hall and the 14th century St.Mary's church. Ascend to Wawel Hill to view the castle as well as the cathedral.

DAY09: KRAKOW/WIELICZKA SALT MINE/BUDAPEST

(Buffet breakfast, Lunch, Hungarian Folkshow Dinner)

- Wieliczka Salt Mine-UNESCO World Heritage Site, The Underground Salt Cathedral of Poland, see the Chapel of St. Kinga and the different chambers.

DAY10: BUDAPEST/VIENNA

(Buffet Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

- Budapest City Tour – The chain Bridge, Castle District, Matthias Church, Fisherman's Bastion, Gellert Hill (Citadel), Photo stop at the Heroes' Square (with statues of the famous Hungarian kings and dukes) • Embark on the Danube river cruise



DAY11: VIENNA/HALLSTATT/SALZBURG

(Buffet Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

- Vienna- Schonbrunn Palace, a former imperial summer residence. Drive through the State Opera and the Rathaus (City Hall) St. Stephen's Cathedral-137 meter high spire, Romanesque and Gothic cathedral. • Hallstatt-a car free village, where you can enjoy the peace and quietness of the town and the serene beauty that awakes you.

DAY12: SALZBURG/DESIGNER OUTLET/ BAVARIA REGION

(Buffet Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

- Salzburg - old town, Mirabelle Garden. Photostop at the birthplace of famous classic music prodigy Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart at No. 9 Getreidegasse • Designer Outlet - Inglostadt Village, where you can enjoy great savings on many major brands.



DAY13: BAVARIA REGION/DUSSELDORF

(Buffet Breakfast, Dinner)

- Today, we will travel back to Dusseldorf for our overnight stay
