**DAY 1 : KUALA LUMPUR → KATHMANDU**

- Depart to Kathmandu, the capital city of Nepal. The natural scenery, high mountains, incomparable cultural heritage and numerous specialties have made Nepal a well-known destination in the world tourism map with a distinct image of its own.
- Upon arrival, transfer to hotel for rest.

**DAY 2 : KATHMANDU (31km) – NAGARKOT (Hotel Breakfast / Local Lunch / Hotel Dinner)**

- Sightseeing tour of **Bhaktapur Durbar Square**, is an assortment of pagoda and shikhara-style temples grouped around a fifty-five-window palace of brick and wood. Including view of Golden Gate, 55 windows Palace, 5 storied Nyatapola temple and Pottery Square.
- Proceed to **Nagarkot**, which is famous for its Himalayan views- the Himalayan peaks at sunrise are a magnificent sight to behold. Its situated at 2,195 meters above the sea level and is the second highest hill around Kathmandu Valley.

**DAY 3 : NAGARKOT (31km) – KATHMANDU (205km) - POKHARA (Hotel Breakfast / Local Lunch / Hotel Dinner)**

- Wake up early morning to experience the spectacular view of sunrise and high snowcapped mountains and as well as sightseeing of the Nagarkot hilltop where one can get the true view of sunrise which you never seen before.
- Proceed to **Pokhara**, a valley which is surrounded by beautiful, amazing and silent Himalayas in the north and mountains.

**DAY 4 : POKHARA (Hotel Breakfast / Local Lunch / Hotel Dinner)**

- Wake up early morning for a excursion tour to **Sarankot hill**. We can see the beautiful sunrise view over Himalaya & Mt. Annapurna Ranges including Fishtail peak during the clear day.
- Then, see the **Davis fall, the Mahadev Cave, the Tibetan Refugee Camp, the Seti Gorge and the Bendabashini Temple.**
- Enjoy a boat ride on picturesque Phewa Lake and free time shopping at lakeside street.

**DAY 5 : POKHARA (105km) – MANAKAMANA (151km) – KATHMANDU**

(Hotel Breakfast / Local Lunch / Hotel Dinner)

- Drive back to Kathmandu. En-route, ride on a cable car to reach the holiest **Manakamana Temple** (1302m) which overlooks terraced fields, and the Trishuli and Marsyangdi river valleys. The hilltop also offers a vantage point for taking in the breathing view of the Manashlu-Himanchuli and Annapurna massifs to the north.

**DAY 6 : KATHMANDU (Hotel Breakfast / Local Lunch / Local Dinner)c**

- Visit to **Patan**, an ancient fortified town, situated about 130 kms. north west of Ahmedabad, on the banks of the sacred Saraswati river. This city is also known as city of wooden crafts and handicrafts. Tour highlights are the **Shikara style Krishna temple, Patan Durbar, Hiranya Varna Mahavihar, a Buddhist monastery and Golden temple.** From here visit the Tibetan cultural center first founded by the Tibetan refugees of the late fifties and now an exhibition cum shopping complex of carpets, jewellery and many interesting souvenirs.
- Visit **Pashupatinath Temple**, reserved as one of the most important pilgrimage sites for Hindu devotees all around the world. The sacred temple has been listed in the UNESCO's World heritage site.
- Visit **Boudhanath Stupa**, built on an octagonal base, is surrounded by prayer wheels, and has colourful prayer flags draped from its 36-metre central spire.

**DAY 7 : KATHMANDU → KUALA LUMPUR (Hotel Breakfast / Local Dinner)**

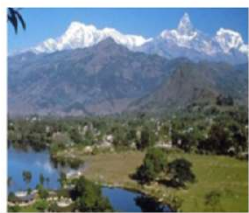
- Sightseeing tour of **Swyambhunath Stupa**, on top of a hill overlooking Kathmandu Valley.
- Proceed to **Kathmandu Durbar Square**, listed as one of the eight World Heritage site by UNESCO, is a cluster of ancient temples, palaces, courtyards and streets that date back to the 12<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> centuries. The square is known to be the social, religious and urban focal point of the Capital City.
- Enjoy the **Rickshaw ride (20mins) around Thamel Street** and free time shopping around the street.
- Farewell dinner with **Nepalese Cultural show.**
- We bid farewell to Nepal and transfer to airport for flight back to home country.
