DAY 1 KUALA LUMPUR ~BEIJING

Hotel : Commune 1958 Hotel / SML

Assemble at Kuala Lumpur International Airport for your flight to the capital of China, Beijing. Arrival Beijing in midnight, transfer to hotel.

DAY 2 BEIJING (B/L/D)

Hotel : Commune 1958 Hotel / SML

After breakfast, proceed to view the "Egg Shell" - **National Grand Theater**, one of the top theater in world. Continue visit the famous place - **Tian'an Men Square**. Tian'an Men Square is located at the heart of Beijing, is the largest urban square in the world and can hold about one million people in the same time. It is surrounded by the Forbidden City in the north, the Great Hall of the People in the west, and the museums of Chinese History and Chinese Revolution in the east. In the center of the square stands the Monument to the People's Heroes. Continue journey to visit **Forbidden City**. The Forbidden City (*Zijincheng*) (also known as the Imperial Palace (*Gugong*) and the Palace Museum) is the largest and best preserved collection of ancient buildings in China. The complex is divided into two sections: the Inner Court or the living quarters, and the working area also known as the Outer Court. Continue visit to **Temple of Heaven** - built in the 15th century and restored in the 18th century. The temple is 123 feet high, was constructed entirely of wood without the use of any nails, making it one of the architectural wonders of the world. The Temple buildings and the parklands reflect ancient Chinese religious beliefs that imagine heaven as round and earth as square. Thus, the buildings in the temple are constructed on a central axis. The temples themselves are round and the bases square. In the night, proceed to enjoy the **Acrobatic Show**.

DAY 3 BEIJING (B/L/D)

Hotel : Hot Spring Resort / SML

In the morning, visit to **Jed Gallery**. Then continue to **Great Wall** - is a series of stone and earthen **fortifications** in **China**, built, rebuilt, and maintained between the 5th century BC and the 16th century to protect the northern borders of the **Chinese Empire** from **Xiongnu** attacks during the rule of **successive dynasties**. Till today it has been a symbolic achievement of the Chinese people. After lunch, visit to **Ming Dynasty Wax Museum**. In the museum's main exhibition hall tells the stories of 16 Ming emperors and important historic episodes in the dynasty that spanned 276 years. A total of 374 wax figures and 26 freeze-frame scenes are displayed and modern audio-video systems are employed to provide visitors with a clue to the political, economic, cultural and social aspects of the dynasty. Continue visit to **Wangfujing Street**, one of the biggest shopping area in Beijing, and you can try the local delicacy at the **Dong Hua Men Night Market**. Stay overnight in **Hot Spring Resort**. Tonight, visitors can enjoy hot spring bath at there (please bring swimsuit & swimming cap).

DAY 4 BEIJING ~ DATONG (B/L/D)

Hotel : Jinhe KaiLong Hotel / SML

In the morning, proceed to **Dongbianmen City Wall**. Then, visit to **YuanDaDu Ruins Park**. It is the largest belt park in the Beijing urban area. The general design will follow the principle of repairing the ruins as the original scene, fully respecting the history and protecting the ruins. Transfer to the second largest city in Shanxi Province, Datong [about 4 hours]. Upon arrival, check in the hotel.

DAY 5 DATONG (B/L/D)

Hotel : Jinhe KaiLong Hotel / SML

After breakfast, visit to UNESCO World Heritage Site, one of the most famous Buddhist sculptural sites in China, **Yungang Grottoes** (exclude buggy). It is an outstanding example of the Chinese stone carvings from the 5th and 6th centuries. All together the site is composed of 252 grottoes with more than 51,000 Buddha statues and statuettes. Continue to **Hanging Monastery**. It is built more than 1,400 years ago; this temple is notable not only for its location on a sheer precipice but also because it includes Buddhist, Taoist, and Confucian elements. The structure is kept in place with wooden crossbeams fitted into holes chiseled into the cliffs. The main supportive structure was hidden.

DAY 6 DATONG ~ BEIJING (B/L/D)

Hotel : Qiaobo International Conference Center / SML

After breakfast, transfer back to Beijing [about 4 hours]. Upon arrival, visit to **Bamboo Charcoal Commodity**. Continue journey to **Summer Palace**. This palace originally called 'Qingyi Garden', like most of the gardens of Beijing, it could not elude the rampages of the Anglo-French allied force and was destroyed by fire. In 1886, **Empress Dowager Cixi** embezzled navy funds to reconstruct it for her own benefit, changing its name to Summer Palace (Yiheyuan). She spent most of her later years there, dealing with state affairs and entertaining. Continue to **Silk Gallery** and **Jewelry Gallery**. Then, take a **tricycle tour in Hutong**. Hutong are a type of narrow streets or alleys, most commonly associated with Beijing. Visit to the most famous bar area in Beijing, **Shishahai Bar Street**. Stay overnight in the only place to ski all year round in Northern China, **Qiaobo Ski Resort**. Experience skiing inside the ski dome of the resort (include ski equipment and 1 hour skiing fees).

DAY 7 BEIJING ~ KUALA LUMPUR (B/L/D)

This morning, experience **Traditional Chinese Medicine Consulting**. Proceed to view the main stadium for the 2008 Olympic Games - National Stadium "**Bird Nest**", and the National Aquatics Center "**Water Cube**". Continue to taste the **Chinese Tea**. After dinner, transfer to Beijing Capital International Airport for your flight back home.

DAY 8 ARRIVAL KUALA LUMPUR
