DAY 1 : KUALA LUMPUR → COLOMBO (166km) - SIGIRIYA (Local Lunch / Hotel Dinner)

- **Depart to Colombo**, the capital city of Sri Lanka.
- Ayubowan! Welcome to a unique experience! Proceed to Sigiriya, is a unique witness to the civilization of Ceylon during the years of the reign of Kassapa I.
- En-route, visit **Dambulla Cave Temple (Golden Temple)**. A sacred pilgrimage site for 22 centuries, this cave temple has the largest number of Buddha statues all housed in one place, including a 14 meter long, colossal figure of the recumbent Buddha carved out of the rock.
- Visit **Sigiriya Rock Fortress**, is home to the 5th Century "Fortress in the Sky" which is perhaps the most fantastic single wonder of the Island. It's also known as Lion Rock because of the huge lion that used to stand at the entrance to the fortress.



DAY 2 : SIGIRIYA (65km) – MATALE (25km) KANDY (Hotel Breakfast / Local Lunch / Hotel Dinner)

- Morning, enjoy the **Elephant Ride** which takes place over the main road, the pathways, villages, jungles, swamp and river.
- **Drive to Kandy**, the second largest city in the country after Colombo. Kandy is an example of the Buddhism's influence in Sri Lanka today. Temple's shrines and monasteries keeping alive Buddhist traditions are everywhere.
- En-ote, visit **Spice Garden** in Matale give interesting insights into spice production such as minor export crops consist of Fragrant clove, cinnamon, cardamom, nutmeg, mace and pepper.
- Kandy city tour including **Upper Lake Drive, Market Square, Arts & Crafts Centre and Gem Museum**.
- Visit **Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic**, houses the tooth of Buddha that was brought to Sri Lanka in the 4th century and is considered the country's most prized possession.
- Evening witness a **cultural dance show** featuring traditional Sri Lankan dances including fire dancing

DAY 3 : KANDY (31km) – NURWARA ELIYA (Hotel Breakfast / Local Lunch / Hotel Dinner)

- Drive to **Nurwara Eliya**, known as Sri Lanka's "Little England", is set against a beautiful backdrop of mountains, valleys, waterfalls and tea plantations.
- Enjoy **Tea Experience** by visiting a tea plantation and factory where you can see how tea leaves are being processed into the famous Ceylon tea.
- After lunch, spend the afternoon at leisure to explore the scenic surroundings of the hill station. you will see evidence of the British influence, houses like country cottages or Queen Ann style mansions.

DAY 4 : NURWARA ELIYA (255km) – GALLE (Hotel Breakfast / Local Lunch / Hotel Dinner)

- **Drive to Galle**, the most perfectly preserved colonial townscape with sedate streets of charming Dutch villas enclosed by a chain of imposing ramparts. Catch a glimpse of the magnificent **Galle Fort**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Other buildings of interest include the Dutch Reformed Church, All Saints Church, Amangalla Hotel and the lighthouse and bell tower.
- Visit **Kosgoda Turtle Hatchery**. Globally, all seven species of marine turtles are endangered and five come ashore to nest in Sri Lanka.

DAY 5 : GALLE (130km) – COLOMBO (Hotel Breakfast / Local Lunch / Hotel Dinner)

- **Drive back to Colombo**. Start off your **Colombo city tour** with a drive through the city taking you to the busy commercial areas as well as the tree-lined residential, Cinnamon Gardens. View the Fort, the former British administrative center and military garrison, Sea Street – the Goldsmith's quarters in the heart of Pettah, the Bazaar area, where is also a Hindu Temple with elaborate stone carvings and the Dutch Church of Wolfendhal dating back to 1749. Also photo-stop at BMICH, see the replica of Avukana Buddha & the Independence Square.
- Visit **Gangaramaya Temple**, The Buddhist temple has a collection of elephant tusks, rare artefacts, and relics of Buddha acquired locally and from abroad.

DAY 6 : COLOMBO → KUALA LUMPUR

(Hotel Breakfast / Local Lunch / Local Dinner with Sri Lankan Lagoon Crabs)

- It's shopping time! Spend time at Barefoot, Saffron Villa, Pettah Bazaar and Odel.
- We bid farewell to Sri Lanka and transfer to airport for flight back to home country.
